On submission of preliminary information to the Republic of Lithuania

Dear Mr Zarandia,

We hereby inform you that Article 217 “Violation of the preliminary information procedure” of the new Code of Administrative Offences of the Republic of Lithuania coming into force on 1 January 2017 will enact new requirements to preliminary information submitted to the customs authorities of Lithuania, notably:

1. Any transport operator will be subject to a fee of 36 Euros in case of non-compliance with the requirement to provide preliminary electronic information on goods 1 hour prior to the vehicle arrival to a customs office in Lithuania.
2. In every consecutive case of non-provision of preliminary information 1 hour prior to arrival of a vehicle to a customs office in Lithuania the transport operator will be subject to a fee of up to 150 Euros.
3. In case of submission of incorrect preliminary information, a warning or a fee of up to 36 Euros can be levied.

We kindly request the IRU to pass the abovementioned information to its member-Associations.
